MISSION

Eluna's mission is to support children, teens, and families impacted by grief or addiction.

VISION

Through the power of community, we ensure no child grieves alone and we break the cycle of addiction.

Camp Erin, the largest grief camp network for school aged youth and their families offering in person and online support.

Camp Mariposa, a year round addiction prevention and mentoring program for youth ages 9–17.

The *Eluna Resource Center*, which offers research-based educational and personalized support.

CAMP ERIN® is the largest grief camp network for kids, teens, and families with programs in 32 locations across the US and Canada. Youth and their adult caregivers receive support through in-person day and overnight camps as well as online programs.

UNDERSTANDING THE NEED

1 in 11 children (over 6 million) in the U.S. experience the death of a parent or sibling before the age of 18. By age 25, this number more than doubles to 15.5 million according to the JAG Institute's Childhood Bereavement Estimation Model.

Grief is universal – everyone will experience it, yet it is as unique as a fingerprint. Societally, grief can feel uncomfortable and is often stigmatized. When this happens, the impacts of grief, such as isolation, strains on mental health, and struggles at school and work, can be heightened for children, teens, and families.



YOUTH CAMPER RACE/ETHNICITY







CAMP MARIPOSA® is a national addiction prevention and mentoring program for youth ages 9–17 who have a family member struggling with a substance use disorder.

UNDERSTANDING THE NEED

One in four children (around 19 million) live with at least one adult who has a substance use disorder (SUD). Youth affected by a family member's addiction who do not receive support are at least 4 times more likely to be affected by substance abuse, anxiety, depression, physical abuse, poverty and suicide (SAMHSA).

Children who grow up in a household with addiction are also 4 times more likely to develop a substance use disorder of their own.

96% of campers report that there are adults they trust at Camp Mariposa.

96% of campers can identify two ways to take care of themselves.

95% of campers have made friends at Camp Mariposa.

93% of youth report no involvement with the juvenile justice system.

92% of youth report no use of substances to get high.

92% of campers have learned skills that will help at home.



Growing up, Kyle felt alone and isolated. At Camp Mariposa she found a community of friends and mentors that transformed her life.

"Everyone needs a home," Kyle shared, "Camp Mariposa is my home."



CAMPER RACE/ETHNICITY



88% of youth have at least one parent who struggles with a SUD.

83% of youth are from low-income households.

80% of youth report having experienced a loss during childhood, with **56**% reporting loss involving a parent.

55% of youth experiencing abuse or neglect at some point during their childhood, with **40**% reporting multiple types of abuse/neglect.

39% of youth have been in foster care or kinship care at some point during childhood.





THE ELUNA RESOURCE CENTER embraces and empowers those it serves, providing support and guidance to youth and families impacted by grief, addiction, and other related mental health issues.

UNDERSTANDING THE NEED

During times of crisis or loss, many families look for trustworthy resources and guidance from trained clinicians that can provide immediate support. The Eluna Resource Center's free library of over 600 resources (both in English and Spanish), and personalized support, ensures help is available anywhere at anytime.

The Resource Library is tailored to a wide range of family needs and locations, bridging the gap in support - particularly for rural and marginalized communities that may lack local grief or addiction prevention services.







